## Reflection



In today's Gospel, Jesus sits on the hillside and offers us a vision of life that turns the world's values upside down. The Beatitudes are not just comforting words; they are a way of life. Jesus calls "happy" those whom the world often overlooks—the poor in spirit, the gentle, the merciful, the peacemakers, those who hunger for what is right. This happiness is not shallow cheerfulness, but a deep, lasting joy rooted in knowing that God is near, God sees, and God's kingdom is already at work among us.

For us at Stella Maris, this Gospel invites us to look honestly at how we live each day. To be poor in spirit is to rely on God rather than on our own strength. To be merciful and pure of heart is to choose forgiveness, compassion, and integrity in our families, workplaces, and community. To be peacemakers is to heal divisions, speak with kindness, and stand for justice even when it costs us. When we live the Beatitudes, we become a living witness of Christ's presence—quietly shaping our parish, our neighborhoods, and our world with the values of God's kingdom. May this Word encourage us not only to admire Jesus' teaching, but to walk it, trusting that true happiness is found in following Him.
